Important note: Romanization for $\, \mathbb{H} \, / \, \mathbb{H} \,$ and $\, \mathbb{H} \, / \, \mathbb{H} \,$ are different, but Koreans pronounce them as 'eh'/'yeh,' so do not get confused and don't worry. [ae]/[eh] can both be pronounced as [eh].







Important note: Formation of these three words are different, but Koreans pronounce them as 'weh,' so do not get confused and don't worry. They all can be pronounced as just [weh].





What are aspirated consonants?


Aspirated consonants refer to a type of consonant sound produced with a burst of breath or a strong puff of air.

For example, compare the following pairs of words:

- 1."pat" (aspirated) vs. "bat" (unaspirated)
- 2. "top" (aspirated) vs. "stop" (unaspirated)
- 3. "kit" (aspirated) vs. "skit" (unaspirated)

In Korean, we have 5 aspirated consonants: ★ヲE耳ㅎ.

EXPLANATION:

The correct pronounciation for letter \equiv is in between L and R. Your tongue does touch the top of your mouth, at the same time your tongue goes to the back of your mouth just **HALFWAY**.






